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ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be the Palomar Mountain Volunteer Fire Department.

ARTICLE II

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

- (a) The specific and primary purposes are to operate a fire department for fire suppression, prevention and rescue purposes.
- (b) The general purposes and powers are to have and exercise all rights and powers conferred on nonprofit corporations under the laws of California, including the power to contract, rent, buy or sell personal or real property, provided, however, that this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the primary purposes of this corporation.
- (c) No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propoganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE III

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This corporation is organized pursuant to the General Nonprofit Corporation Law of the State of California. This corporation does not contemplate pecuinary gain or profit to the members thereof and is organized for nonprofit purposes.

ARTICLE IV

The principal office for the transaction of business of this corporation is loacted in the County of San Diego, State of California.

ARTICLE V

The general management of the affairs of this corporation shall be under the control, supervision and direction of the Board of Directors. The names and addresses of persons who are to act in the capacity of directors until the selection of their successors are:

property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets this organization shall ever inure to the benefit of any Upon the dissolution or winding.up of individual. the corporation, its assets remaining after payment of, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation, shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusfor charitable purposes and which has established its tax exemption status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal If this corporation holds any assets in trust, Revenue Code. corporation is formed for charitable purposes, such assets shall be disposed of in such manner as may be directed. decree of the superior court of the county in which the corporation has its principal office, upon petition therefore by the Attorney General or by a person concerned in the liquidation, or in a proceeding to which the Attorney General in a party.
